Car Rider Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Before leaving home, parents should screen children for symptoms and fever. If your child has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher, without the use of fever-reducing medications such as Tylenol or Motrin, they should not go to school.● If at all possible, please do not bring your child to school until 7:55 am. This will help us social distance before teachers arrive on campus.● Hand sanitizer units will be available at all entrances and exits. Everyone is expected to use them upon entrance.● Students report to the concrete slabs when arriving at school. In the event of inclement weather, K-2 students will report to the cafeteria, and 3-5 students will report to the shelter.● Please make sure your child uses the restroom prior to coming to school. This will help elevate number of children in the restroom prior to school.● Masks are required for all students and visitors in school buildings. At this time, masks are highly encouraged for staff.
Breakfast	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Breakfast will be delivered to classrooms at 8:00am by cafeteria staff except K-1 will eat in the cafeteria.● Teachers will supervise students eating breakfast in the classroom.● Breakfast is FREE to all students.● Students will order breakfast the day before each school day in order to prepare the grab and go breakfasts for each class.

<p>Class Setting</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students are required to wear a face covering. ● Students will be arranged in a format that creates as much social distance as possible. ● Students will have individually bagged or boxed materials and tools such as pencils, crayons, markers, etc. ● Students will be assigned the same chromebook for daily use. ● Students' headphones will be bagged and labeled. ● All classes will use assigned seating.
<p>Class Changing/Face Coverings</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students, parents and visitors are required to wear face masks. ● At this time, staff members are strongly encouraged to wear face coverings. ● Masks will be available at each school site for students, staff and visitors who need them. ● Face Coverings will not be required for outside activities.
<p>Bathroom/Hydration</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Teachers will spend additional time with students covering proper hygiene practices. Reminders and signage will be used. ● Custodial staff will provide additional restroom cleanings. ● All water fountains will be turned off. We have two water bottle filling stations. ● Students need to bring clean water bottles from home each day. ● If needed, the school will provide paper water cups
<p>Lunch</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will be socially distanced in the cafeteria by leaving space in between seated students. ● Students will sit in number line order in the cafeteria. ● Students will be allowed to remove their mask during lunch ● Lunch may be brought from home by students. However, no lunch deliveries by outside vendors or parents are allowed. This also includes deliveries of flowers, balloons and other gifts. ● Lunch is FREE to all students.
<p>Recess/Physical Activity</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Hand sanitizer units will be located at all entrances and exits. Students and staff will be expected to use prior to recess and upon returning to the building.

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<p style="text-align: center;">End of Day/Dismissal</p>	<p><u>Walkers</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will be dismissed around 3:20 pm. Students are expected to leave campus quickly. ● Students are expected to wear a face covering while moving throughout and exiting the building. <p><u>Car Riders</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Car riders will stay in their classroom where they will watch for their name to be displayed on the classroom projector. ● Students will be called to the car rider line and exit their classroom to walk to the front of the school where a duty teacher will assist in directing them to their car. ● Students are expected to wear a face covering until they exit the building. ● Parents are to remain in their car. Please make sure you have your number hanging on your rearview mirror.
<p style="text-align: center;">Elevated Temperature</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Upon discovery of a student having a temperature of 100 or higher - office staff will escort the student to the isolation room and contact parent/guardian for pick up. Teachers will use a google form to notify the office that a child is sick. ● Classroom teachers have been instructed not to notify parents regarding elevated temperature. All communication about sick students will occur through the school nurse or main office.
<p style="text-align: center;">Triage Space</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The nurse's room will be the Covid Isolation room. ● The triage space will be used when individuals have a temperature of 100 or higher and/or if other symptoms are exhibited that could be Covid related. ● Students will be placed in an Isolation Pod until the child is picked up from school.
<p style="text-align: center;">Visitor Protocols</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We ask parents to communicate via zoom, phone, email, app, etc., as much as possible. ● All visitors that are on campus will be screened and expected to

	<p>wear a mask.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Parents will not escort students to class.● Parents will be allowed to attend assemblies. Masks are required.
Daily Cleaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● In addition to regular custodial services, another custodian will be in the building regularly cleaning high touch surfaces throughout the day including more frequent cleaning of restrooms.
Other Considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● It is extremely important for parents to keep updated contact numbers and email addresses on file with the office in the event of illness or emergency. Please have a few emergency contacts listed.
